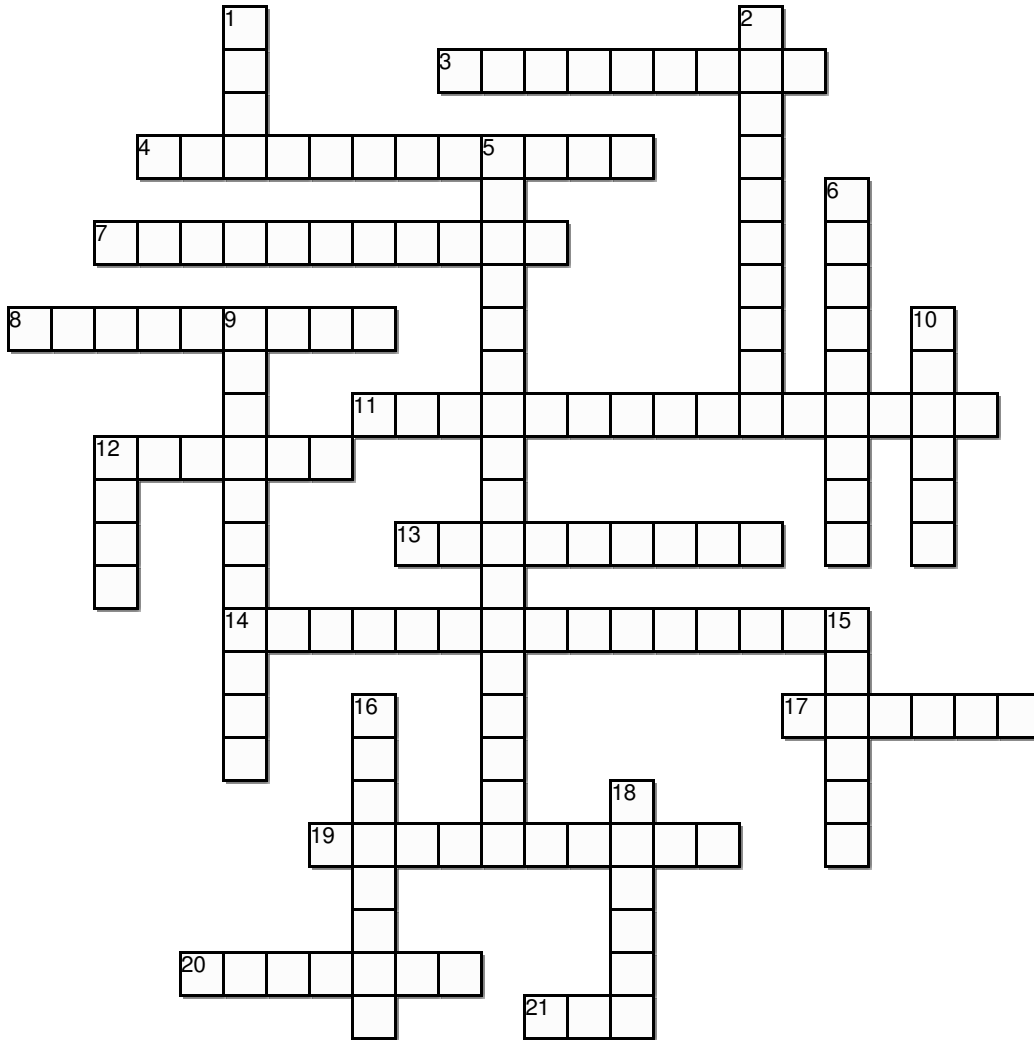


WWII Overview
