In the Proclamation of 1763, Great Britain decided that the Americans should not be allowed beyond what mountain range?	In 1765, Great Britain passed the first direct tax on the American colonists to help offset the cost of defending North America. Name this tax on newspapers, legal documents and other printed goods.	Also in 1765, this act forced colonists to house and feed British troops. Name the act.
In July 1765, THIS group is formed. They use violence and intimidation to eventually force all British stamp agents to stop collecting the tax. Members of this group included Samuel Adams, John Adams, Patrick Henry, and Paul Revere.	In March 1770, THIS event occurred when British soldiers fired their muskets into a mob of angry colonists, killing five and injuring six.	In December 1773, a group of colonists dress as Mohawk Indians board ships in Boston Harbor and dump 342 containers of tea in THIS event.	On April 19, 1775, colonists clashed with British soldiers at THIS battle, known as the "Shot Heard 'round the World."
