ST MATH HOME DIRECTIONS: (Mathematics) - 90 minutes weekly in the classroom. Home support based on student progress and Teacher Recommendation.

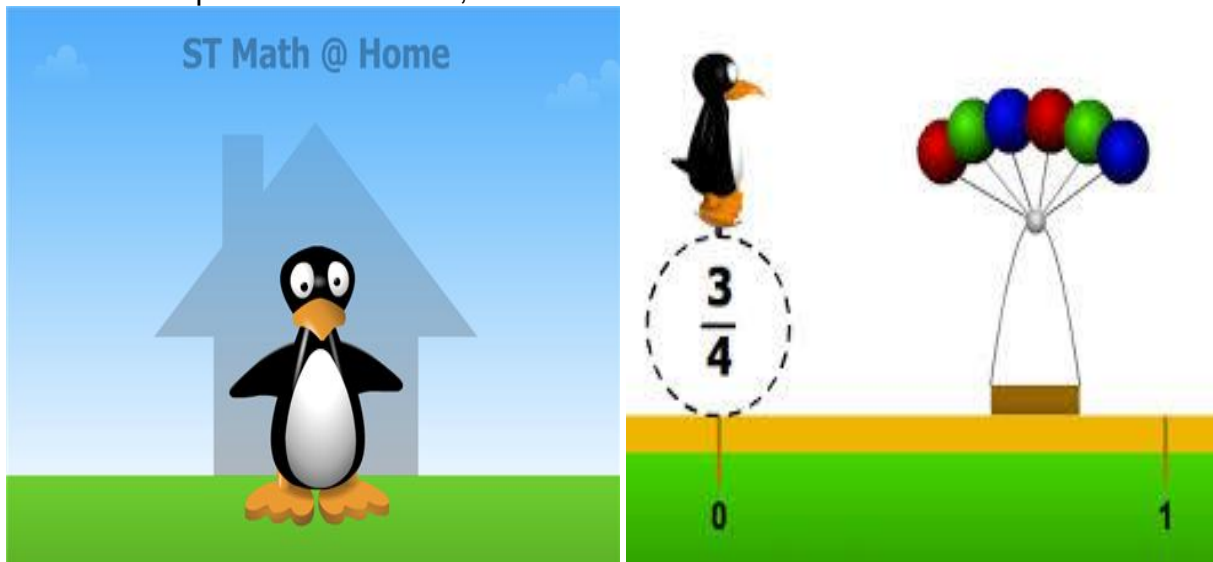
Benchmark Goals:

1. Classroom Teacher assigns ST Math games and levels for homework. Please make sure that only the child with the ST Math Account plays the games.

3. EXIT ST MATH correctly to Save progress. Click BACK ARROW to see Today Accomplishments Screen, Select X button to save.



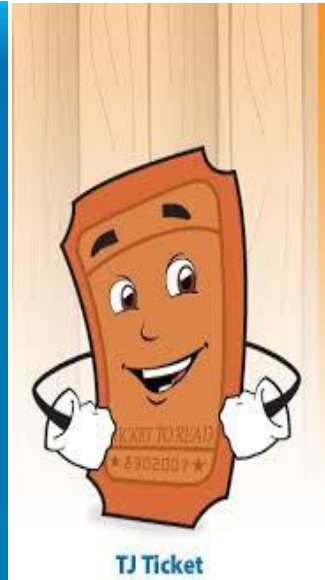
TICKET TO READ HOME DIRECTIONS: (Reading Fluency/Comprehension) -45-60 minutes weekly at home for RAH
