Class Rank:

YLHS does not rank students. The size of the senior class of 2016 is **449**.

Grading Scale:

A 4.0 scale is utilized. A=90-100%, B=80-89%, C=70-79%, D=60-69%, F=Below 60%. In 2014-15, courses identified as honors level by the UC system were given an extra grade point. Starting in 2015-16, all courses identified as AP or Honors are being given an extra grade point. The average weighted GPA for the class of 2015 was 3.35.

16 Honors Courses:

Honors classes offered are Geometry, Algebra 2/ Trigonometry, Pre-Calculus, Biology, Chemistry, Chinese 3, French 2 & 3, German 2 & 3, Japanese 2 & 3, Spanish 2 & 3, Language Arts 1 & 2.

23 AP Courses Offered

Calculus AB, Calculus BC, Statistics, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Environmental Science, Chinese, French, German, Japanese, Spanish, European History, US Government and Politics, Macro Economics, United States History, Human Geography, English Language and Composition, English Literature, Computer Science, Studio Art (2D, 3D and Drawing).

Due to a limit of 6 classes per semester, the maximum number of AP courses that one student can take is 14.
