Required Dress Code for all Students

6th Grade Supply List



The following supplies are needed for all 6th grade students at Mission Junior High, regardless of the team on which they are placed.

- Package of red pens with lids – no “clicking” pens
- Package of blue pens with lids – no “clicking” pens
- Two (2) 1-inch “view” binders (with the clear “pocket” on the covers) – a team binder and a math binder
- 2 packages of dividers
- Pencils – 6 packages
- Eraser caps – 3 packages
- 6 “block” polymer erasers (white)
- 4 packages of lined notebook paper – college ruled (one for social studies, two for ELAR, 1 for math)
- 1 folder with brads and pockets – for social studies
- 1 spiral notebook (not perforated) – for social studies
- 6 composition books
- 2 packages of colored copy paper (NOT construction paper) – one for science, one for ELAR
- Pencil pouch (for team binder)
- 6 Large Elmer’s glue sticks
- Ear buds – for Istation and other classroom computer programs
- Coloring materials: crayons, markers, and/or colored pencils
- Scissors
- 2 boxes of tissues
- Germ-X – no “travel-sized” bottles
